TODAY'S SCRIPTURE

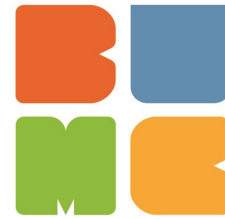

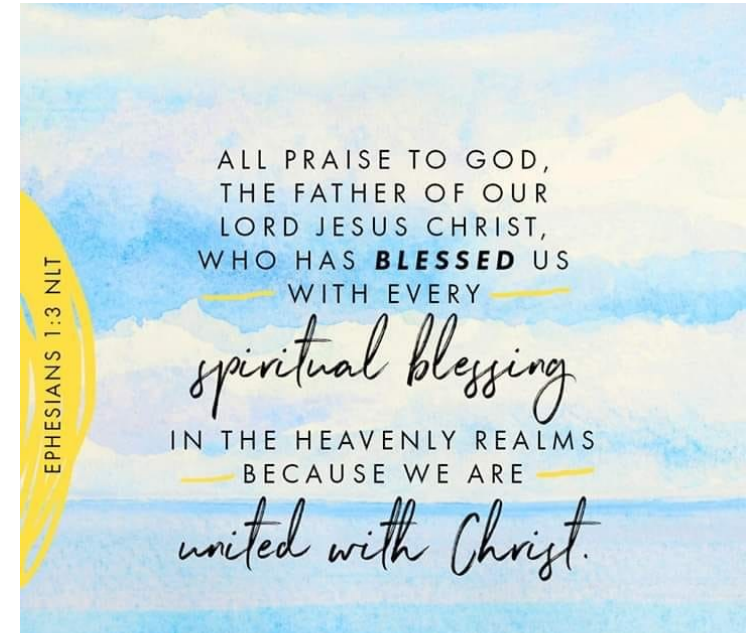
